

Do I Qualify?

- I live in Surrey
- My family's net income from line 236 of my/our Notice of Assessment(s) combined is below the thresholds indicated below **AND** is above \$7,500.
 - Applications with a family net income lower than \$7,500 must be reviewed by a Leisure Access supervisor and may require additional information or documentation.
- I have provided all of the required documents.

Family Income Thresholds							
Family Size	1	2	3	4	5	6	7
Family Net Income	\$19,307	\$23,498	\$29,260	\$36,504	\$41,567	\$46,099	\$50,631

Income for families greater than seven will be based on \$50,631 plus \$7,233 per person above seven.

How do I Apply?

Complete this form and bring it to any Surrey Parks, Recreation and Culture centre along with all the required documents. A Leisure Access Pass will be granted if all of the conditions listed in the "Do I Qualify?" section are met. A small non-refundable administration fee is required in order to process your application. This information is considered confidential and will not be disclosed except as required by law.

Which Documents Do I Need to Supply?

- Complete documentation (originals only) is required in order to process your application.
- Only the most current documents will be accepted

Leisure Access Pass – Client Application

The City of Surrey Leisure Access Program is designed to support Surrey residents who are in financial need. The application process supports the diversity of family structures within the community and addresses eligibility based on family net income, as defined by the Canada Revenue Agency.

A Leisure Access Pass provides the following benefits to its holders:

- One-year Full Facility Family Pass valid at all City of Surrey facilities.
- 75% discount on most registered programs - inquire with staff regarding eligible programs.
